

**Petition Statement:** Residents who live in proximity to the property known as Wallace Farm, 14410 Eastfield Rd. call for the immediate enforcement of the current zoning for this property. Since receiving a Type III Solid Waste Compost permit from the State of North Carolina in May of 2001, the property has blatantly operated outside the scope of what is allowable in an R-3 zone. The permitted use of the property is clearly documented as that of a farm, with composting limited to a secondary function of the farming operation. It is well known that this property has ceased virtually all farming activities that they had conducted prior to 2001 and has replaced its primary use (as a farm) with a new use (food sludge composting). The noxious odors associated with this full time solid waste facility have caused to disrupt, interfere and significantly harm those who live in Highland Creek (over 3500 homes), Skybrook and other adjacent subdivisions. The loss of the enjoyment and devaluation of our real estate is overshadowed by the illness and potential health hazards caused by liquids being discharged from the property and the indescribable stench of decaying food products mixed with manure. Our petition is for swift and appropriate enforcement measures in respect to the clear violations of the use of this property.
